### Oberammergau's Passion Play in June 2020

**From June 5-18, 2020**, Fr. Edmundo is leading a pilgrimage to Germany to attend an epic performance of the Live Oberrammergau Passion Play that is staged every 10 years in a small village in the Bavarian Region.

The pilgrimage also includes trips to Krakow, Prague, Vienna & Salzburg. This passion play - a dramatic recreation of the last days of Jesus, covering the last supper, to the crucifixion and concluding with the resurrection - has been a fundamental element of Christian life in Oberammergau since the mid 17th century.

The story begins in 1633 when the village was devastated by the 30 Years War (a pan-European conflict) and

the bubonic plague raging across Europe. Those who survived these horrible ordeals made a vow that if God spared them, they would put on a performance detailing Christ's own suffering - and repeat the gesture every ten years in gratitude for their deliverance.

The 2020 season will be the 42nd production & the role of Jesus will be played by a practicing psychologist. He will be one of over 2000 actors & behind-the-scenes technicians who will take part in the play, all of whom are Oberammergau residents.
